LOCATION: Santarém is located 80km North of Lisbon, and is the lively capital of the main agricultural region of the country, the plane of the river Tejo. Located on a strateg hill overlooking the Tejo river, Santarém is an attractive historical town, with human occupation from pre-historic to Roman, Visigoth, Arab to the establishment of Portugal on the 12th century. It is recognized for its gothic patrimony, and the agricultural capital of Portugal, hosting every year the National Agriculture Fair on the first two weeks of June, where the workshop will take place. It is also recognized for its Portuguese gastronomy festival ("tasquinhas") and its bullfights riding on the horse. It is on this attractive "Mediterranean" lively atmosphere that our workshop will take place.

TRANSPORT: Santarém is at some 45⁻, highway drive, from Lisbon International Airport, and it is served by hourly trains and buses to and from Lisbon city Centre.

ACCOMODATION: IAMAW Workshop does not take care of hotel reservation for participants but made a limited amount of bloc pre-reservations for the workshop in the two available Hotels at Santarém. These pre-reservations are valid for a limited period (until 1st April). Participants are encouraged to make reservations **ASAP**, since hotels are highly requested during the time of the National Agriculture Fair! SHORT ABSTRACTS:

Abstracts should be sent to iamaw.workshop@gmail.com ASAP and latest on the 31st March. Abstracts sent until the end of February will be given preference for oral communications.

The abstracts, <u>describing the scientific, technological or economical achievements</u> but avoiding generalities or lengthy introductions, must be written according to the specifications below:

- o Documents in word or rich text format
- Text (including references and acknowledgments) with a maximum of 2000 characters, including spaces. The abstract must be typed in Arial font 12 points, 1,5x space paragraph with margins of 2,5 cm. The text alignment should be justified.
- Title must be in capital letters, and the <u>presenting author name underlined</u>.
 Double space paragraph must be used between the title section, the authors affiliation section and the main text of the abstract.
- References may be included (maximum 3, preferably from the authors) and should obey the following rule: -Complete title, Authors, Publication, volume, page numbers and year of the publication.
- The complete abstract must not be of more than one page when printed. One extra page with relevant Figures and tables can be added if necessary.
- A short CV of the presenting author, showing academic and/or professional degrees, present and past positions, and main scientific and professional experience and achievements, of half to a maximum of one page, must be included.

DEADLINES:

- -Short Abstract submission with registration: Two selection periods:29th February and 31st Marchs.
- -Registration Payment without extra cost: 15th April. Later registrations will be charged with an additional €50.
- -Accepted abstracts will be required to send an extended abstract (4-6 pages) for the workshop proceedings. Extended abstracts will be due on the 15th May.

NOTES: A selection of the Papers presented at the workshop will be used for presentation to a specialized journal.
